Memorandum of understanding and cooperation between project partners and representatives of competent institutions and the media in the field of Sustainable Employment and Inclusive Economic Growth of Cross-Border Region of Albania and Montenegro

Memorandum o razumijevanju i saradnji između partnera na projektu i predstavnika nadležnih institucija i medija u oblasti održivog zapošljavanja i inkluzivnog ekonomskog rasta prekograničnog regiona Albanije i Crne Gore

Bearing on mind that the joint problems analysis in the cross-border region between Albania and Montenegro suggested:

- poor employment prospects for young people and women in the border region, who either remain unemployed for not possessing skills that match the local labour market needs or migrate from less developed to more developed parts of the of Montenegro and Albania or abroad;
- lack of more adequate and targeted programmes of formal and informal education for youth and women and the insufficient use of dual education that could increase employment skills which are in demand in the labour market, but which must be preceded by larger consultations with the employers in the CB region

Imajući u vidu da je zajednička analiza problema u prekograničnom području Albanije i Crne Gore sugerisala da postoje:

- loši izgledi za zapošljavanje mladih ljudi i žena u pograničnom području, koji ili ostaju nezapošljeni jer ne posjeduju vještine koje odgovaraju potrebama lokalnog tržista rada ili migriraju iz manje razvijenih u razvijenije djelove Crne Gore i Albanije, ili u inostranstvo;
- nedostaci adekvatnijih i ciljanih programa formalnog i neformalnog obrazovanja za mlade i žene i nedovoljna upotreba dualnog obrazovanja koje bi moglo unaprijediti vještine koje su tražene na tržistu rada. Unaprijeđenju navedenog treba da prethode konsultacije sa poslodavcima u prekograničnom području.

Foundation Business Start-up Centre Bar in collaboration with Chamber of Economy of Montenegro and Albanian Investment Development Agency have developed project entitled **Skills for Jobs – Albania and Montenegro**.

Objective of the Project is focusing on **building employability and entrepreneurship skills of the unemployed youth and women** as the key target group, but also **provision of sustainable support to the employers in the CB area**, who are crucial stakeholders in tackling the unemployment challenges.

Given the priority development sectors in the CB area (tourism, ICT, hospitality, agriculture and interlinked sectors), and in consultation with the employers and other relevant stakeholders, the contribution to the Impact of the proposed Project will be achieved through three Specific Objectives/Outcomes:

OC1: *Increased professional skills and competencies of unemployed youth and women in the cross - border region to match the employment demands in the tourism, ICT and hospitality sector;*

OC2: *Developed self-employment / entrepreneurship skills - strategic planning, networking, marketing and sales, e-business - among young people and women in the cross-border region in the area of ICT, tourism, hospitality, gastronomy and traditional crafts; and*

OC3: *Established a cross-border brand for the promotion of local products and services, with the aim of improving competitiveness, self-employment, preconditions for further*

Fondacija Biznis start centar Bar je u saradnji sa Privrednom komorom Crne Gore i Albanskim agencijom za razvoj investicija razvila projekat pod nazivom "Vještine za posao – Albanija i Crna Gora".

Cilj projekta je unaprijeđenje zapošljivosti i preduzetničkih veština nezapošljenih mladih i žena kao ključne ciljne grupe, ali i pružanje održive podrške poslodavcima u prekograničnoj oblasti, koji su ključni akteri u suočavanju sa izazovima nezaposlenosti.

Imajući u vidu prioritetne razvojne sektore u prekograničnoj oblasti (turizam, informaciono komunikacione tehnologije, ugostiteljstvo, poljoprivreda i međusobno povezani sektori), uz konsultacije sa poslodavcima i drugim relevantnim zainteresovanim stranama, doprinos uticaju predloženog projekta će se postići kroz tri specifična cilja:

OC1: Povećane profesionalne vještine i kompetencije nezapošljenih mladih i žena u prekograničnom regionu kako bi se zadovoljile potrebe za zapošljavanjem u sektoru turizma, informaciono-komunikacionih tehnologija i ugostiteljstva;

OC2: Razvijene vještine samozapošljavanja/ preduzetništva – strateško planiranje, umrežavanje, marketing i prodaja, e-poslovanje – među mladima i ženama u prekograničnom regionu u oblasti ICT-a, turizma, ugostiteljstva, gastronomije i tradicionalnih заната i

Project is implemented in cross border region with specific focus on following areas:

Montenegro: Podgorica, Tuzi, Danilovgrad, Budva, Bar, Ulcinj and Old Royal Capital Cetinje

Albania: Municipality of Shkoder, Municipality of Vau i Dejes, and Municipality of Malesia e Madhe
